Our story

In August of 2008, fifteen women began a hockey team called Rosey's Racers. The only stipulation of the team was that all players had to be out of high school. In the beginning, the group was only looking to learn or improve their hockey skills. Some were completely new to hockey and skating for that matter. Others had played when young but not in a while. The word got out and, in October of 2008, the group doubled to thirty women (and a waiting list) looking for a new challenge, sisterhood, and exercise.

As the team's skills improved, naturally the competitiveness came out and soon they were interested in playing a "real" game. With few teams in the area, the group decided it might make more sense to host a tournament for 20+ women.

In the midst of the pre-planning, pondering stage, one of the Rosey's Racers teammates lost a sister to breast cancer that had spread to her liver. It was then and there that the group decided the proceeds from our tournament should go to support women's cancers in the North Country. So we do this in honor of all the women of our lives that have valiantly fought a form of gynecological or breast cancers.

Tournament Rules

1. USA Hockey registered referees will be used.
2. Players must be 20+ years old and registered with USA Hockey or Hockey Canada
3. Teams may register in one of two divisions: Recreational or Open.
4. Players can be rostered on one team only - excluding goalies.
5. Teams are guaranteed 3 games. Top two point winners for each division will play for championship.
6. Teams will have a 3-minute warm up time before each game.
7. Games will consist of three 12 minute stop time periods
8. Each team will be allowed 1 one-minute time out per game.
9. Running time in the third period is used when there is a 5 or more goal differential. Should the differential go below 5, the clock returns to stop time.
